



COVID-19 PREVENTION, CONTAINMENT AND MITIGATION KNOW HOW TO COMPLY

THROUGHOUT CONTINENTAL PORTUGAL

IT IS MANDATORY TO STAY AT HOME FOR:

- Patients with COVID-19 and infected with SARS-Cov2
- Citizens under active surveillance by the health authority or other health professionals

IT IS MANDATORY TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- Physical distance and hand hygiene
- Use of mask or visor
 - In closed spaces
 - On public transport
 - In vehicles with more than 5 seats, except for those under 10 years of age or holders of a medical declaration

IT IS FORBIDDEN THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN STREETS AND OUTDOOR PUBLIC SPACES

- Except on properly licensed outdoor seating

GATHERINGS OF MORE THAN 20 PEOPLE ARE PROHIBITED

ATTENTION:

- Private vehicles with capacity of more than 5 people can only be two thirds full (unless all occupants are part of the same household)



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IN THE METROPOLITAN AREA OF LISBON

- Commercial establishments close at 8 pm, except for restaurants, petrol stations (only for sale of fuel and vehicle supplies to the public), pharmacies and doctors' offices
- In restaurants, after 8 pm, sale of alcoholic beverages is allowed only if you are having a meal
- Supermarkets and hypermarkets can operate until 10 pm. Sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited from 8 pm
- Sale of alcoholic beverages at petrol stations is prohibited
- Gatherings of more than 10 people (or 5 people in the areas of the Lisbon Metropolitan Area categorised as being in a state of calamity) are prohibited

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES
INCURS A FINE OF BETWEEN 100 EUROS
AND 500 EUROS
